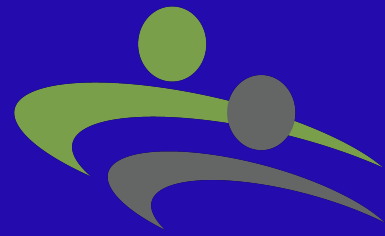

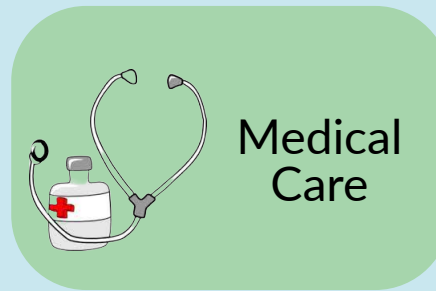

Overview of Charlotte Community Health Clinic

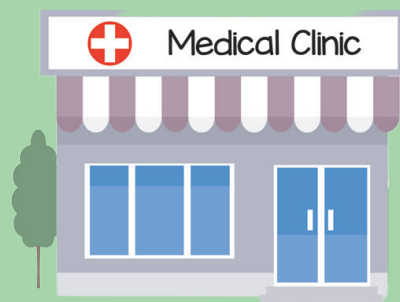
